More on Aman resorts' second Caribbean property, and its first integrated golf resort: On 2,000 acres of coastline in the Dominican Republic, Amanera promises to deliver all the bells and whistles, of both design and service, that its fans around the world have come to expect; most of the casitas have private infinity pools and sighprovoking ocean views. This time, though, there's a club next to the 18-hole championship course with a perfectly situated post-game bar, to complement the resort's beach club, where hammocks and tables in the sand bring the atmosphere down to more laid-back island level.

The test dinners are in full swing at Fifth Quarter, the new restaurant in the **Hotel Vagabond**, opening next month in the Kampong Glam quarter of Singapore. The 'art' hotel—the first to be launched by investor/developer/polo player/man-about-town Satinder Garcha—has been designed by Jacques Garcia and will supposedly feature original work by some of Southeast Asia's finest and best-known talents (as well as photographs taken by Garcha himself). It's the first quality hotel to open in this low-rise neighborhood of shop houses and shisha bars (which also goes by the name Arab Street); Garcha's other two projects are in Chinatown—more on those early next year.
