2. HOTEL VAGABOND'S EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED

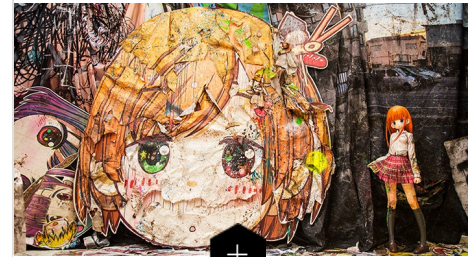
Perfect for: A venturesome dip into the unorthodox.

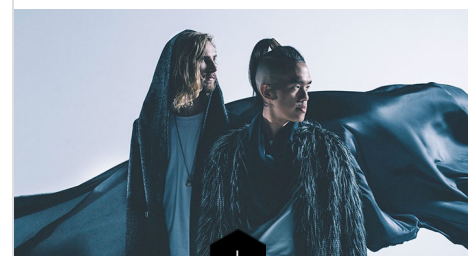

When and where: 17 September, 10pm at CATO.



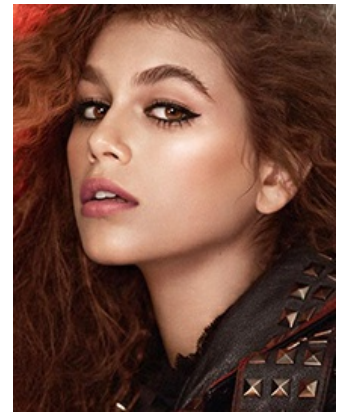
