Luxury hotels are aplenty, so why not check out one of the more exotic boutique hotels in Singapore instead? Boutique hotels are considered smaller sized hotels with uniquely designed interiors as well as maintaining luxurious accommodations.

Many of these Singapore boutique hotels are specially constructed by award-winning creatives, and truly gives an out-of-country experience while still remaining in Singapore.

Staying in the country also means you can splurge a little more on accommodation – instead of spending on the air tickets, which usually sets us back at least a couple hundred dollars.

Check out this list of pretty reasonably priced boutique hotels with the extremely creative interiors you can stay at during your next hotel visit. Do note that hotel rates fluctuate according to season, and the prices shown below are the best available rates during a slow season for standard rooms.

## 1. AMOY Singapore Hotel

AMOY's design, inspired by the people of ZhengZhou when they came by sea from China in the 1820s to settle in Singapore, tells the story of Singapore's trading past.

With differentiated preserved shophouse-style rooms and even the entrance (also a museum) being converted from one of the oldest temples in Singapore, AMOY boutique hotel screams of history and heritage.

With a cosy number of just 37 guest rooms, the hotel focuses on providing guests with personalised services and even prides itself on knowing every customer by name.

Located in Far East Square, guests also get to experience the charm and locale of this heritage conservation project brimming with cafes, restaurants, pubs, pushcarts and shops with tons of food options. Get the full heritage experience full of Chinese vibes.

AMOY currently has a staycation package – [AMOY Weekend Experience](#) that comes with a complimentary meal at JIN Fine Dining. The package, starting from rates of \$268, includes a one-night stay in Deluxe Double Room (Modern Chinese Heritage-themed room), a breakfast buffet, paired mini-wine, a mini bar, internet access and free local calls.

Fun fact: its museum entrance was the first stopping point for many of the first Chinese immigrants back in the 1820s!

## 2. Hotel Vagabond

Hotel Vagabond is a new boutique hotel in Singapore, featuring Parisian-chic red and gold interiors designed by French designer Jacques Garcia.

With a strong emphasis on the love of arts, you'll notice iconic installations like a life-sized golden elephant and solid brass rhinoceros by sculpteur Franck Le Ray. The lift also features a quirky video art installation by Marco Brambilla, tying together an eclectic and intimate ambiance.

Within the hotel, the Vagabond Salon is always ready to showcase performing artists together with great burgers and cocktails.

Its classic rooms feature a unique mix of vintage and modern amenities, adorned with photos from around the world taken by hotelier Satinder Garcha himself. With dark solid hardwood floors and Italian marble and glass mosaic bathrooms, Hotel Vagabond spares no attention to detail to create an adventurous boutique hotel setting.

### **3. M Social Hotel**

The contemporary loft-style rooms at M Social hotel allow guests to retreat to a comforting space, with tall bay windows that allow natural light for that homely atmosphere.



A quirky, eclectic hotel located in a great neighborhood, the refreshing duplex rooms at M Social makes it stand apart from the common 5-star hotels.

With an urban, functional-chic design, one can appreciate the amount of detail put into this boutique hotel to make it comforting and aesthetically pleasing to guests. Prices are really reasonable here too!

#### **4. Klapsons, The Boutique Hotel**

If you want a mix of creativity and luxury, then pop by Klapsons. There are only 17 rooms at this hotel, and each one is designed differently, so that no two are the same! You would have to stay here over 17 times to experience each and every one. Not missing out on comfort, the rooms are spacious and inviting, with soft, carpeted floors; it is affordable yet high class.

Klapson was probably designed as a **romantic couple hotel** – The shower cubicle has no curtains or blinds, and is located in the open right beside the bed though, so make sure its not awkward before booking a room here.

## 5. Lloyd's Inn

## **7. Hotel 1929**



As a heritage-listed building, Hotel 1929 preserves its shop-house architecture by designing its rooms around the fixed building of yesteryear.

Literally walk down the memory lane as you pass through the corridors, which showcase black and white photos of olden day Singapore. Rest assured that the room designs do not follow the historical construction of the hotel – they are hip and stylish, with pops of colour that brighten up the place.

## **8. Kam Leng Hotel**

Kam Leng hotel place goes all the way back to 1927, when it was first established in Singapore.

Reopening after a revamp in 2012, this boutique hotel started to feature a newer and more contemporary look. The latest overhaul lets you get a mixture of modern yet nostalgic details – like the old-style wooden windows and façade of the building. Be charmed by the lovely Nanyang and Chinoiserie designs when you book a room here.
