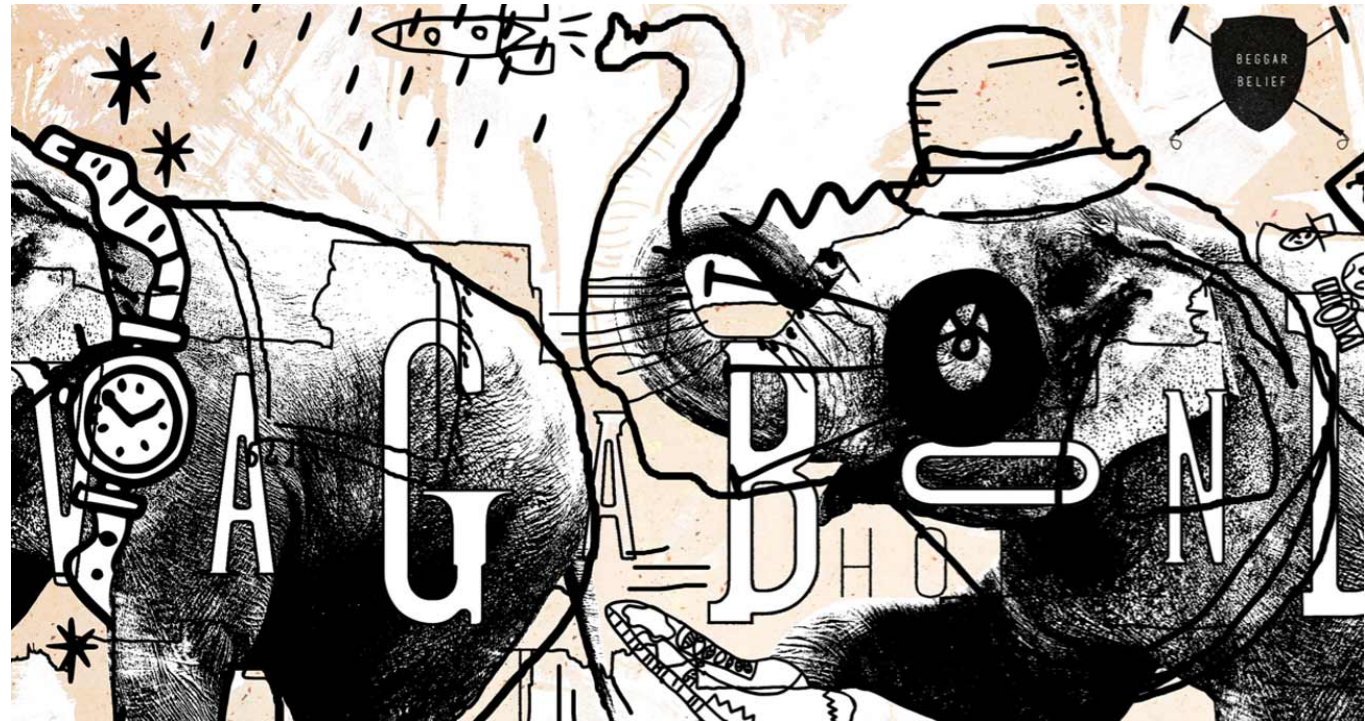

VAGABOND IN RESIDENCE



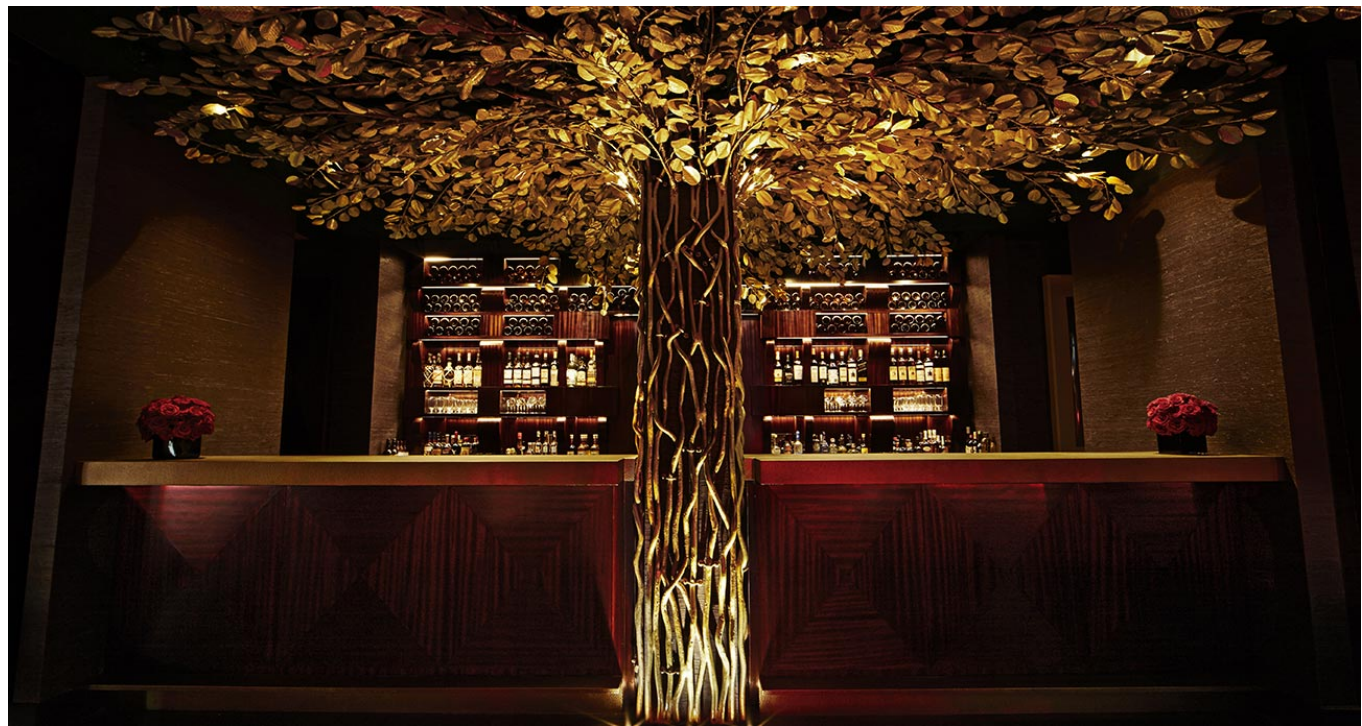
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With interiors as luxuriously indulgent as those from the 2001 film *Moulin Rouge*, but peppered with cutting edge contemporary art, **Hotel Vagabond** is a first for Singapore. Housed in a heritage Art Deco building, the picture-frame lined walls reflect the hotel's unique draw: the first, and hitherto only, hotel in Singapore to offer an artist-in-residence program. With a focus on writers, poets, musicians, and performers, artists are invited to apply for anything from a one week to a three month residency at the hotel, where they are encouraged to mingle, create, and perform on one of the establishment's many social platforms. As well as the reams of artworks throughout the hotel, there is a small cinema room showing cult classics, occasional jazz performances in the *Vagabond Salon*, and nothing inspires more than an artisanal cocktail shaken – or stirred – at the bar. But while the fun and games reach into the early hours downstairs, there is sanctuary to be found in the uncompromising luxury of the rooms and suites upstairs, each complete with a king sized bed, goose down pillows, Egyptian cotton sheets and Turkish towels. It is a true blend of masterful design, by *Jacques Garcia*, international understanding, and gregarious entertainment. And who's to say you can't bring the party upstairs?
